AOT has six airports under its responsibility, i.e., Suvarnabhumi Airport, Don Mueang International Airport, Chiang Mai International Airport, Mae Fah Luang - Chiang Rai International Airport, Phuket International Airport, and Hat Yai International Airport, and these six airports provide domestic and international flights, with Suvarnabhumi Airport being the country's primary airport. Furthermore, AOT operates aviation-related businesses by investing in its subsidiaries, as follows.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. AOT Ground Aviation Services Company Limited (AOTGA) provides ground, cargo terminal and cleaning services under international safety standards and with highest efficiency, and such services are rendered by professionals and modern technology.</li><li>2. AOT Aviation Security Company Limited (AOT AVSEC) provides airport security service and operates with international professionalism and is certified by the Civil Aviation Authority of Thailand (CAAT). AOT TAFA Operator Company Limited (AOTTO) establishes facilities for preparation of agricultural and perishable products and quality inspection prior to export through Perishable Premium Lane. This is to upgrade the goods standards and create perishable agricultural product inspection standards for Thai exporters and farmers, and to increase the speed in inspection of agricultural products to maintain their quality and standard before export to target destinations, where the inspection will be on the same level as European Union's standards, which will also contribute to Thailand becoming the regional import and export hub for agricultural products.</p> <p>Therefore, AOT has not yet had a plan to provide services other than airport-related activities.</p>
